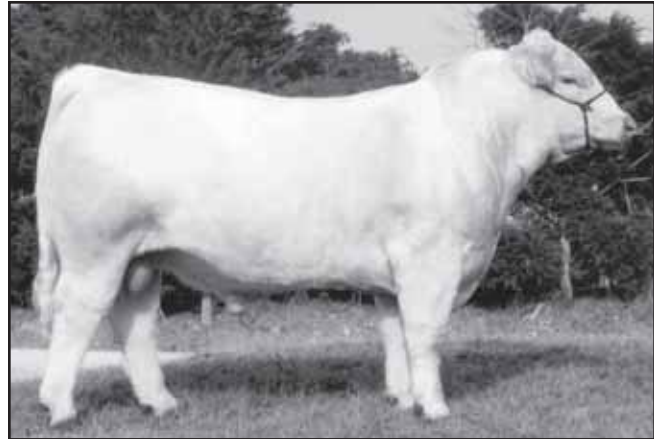

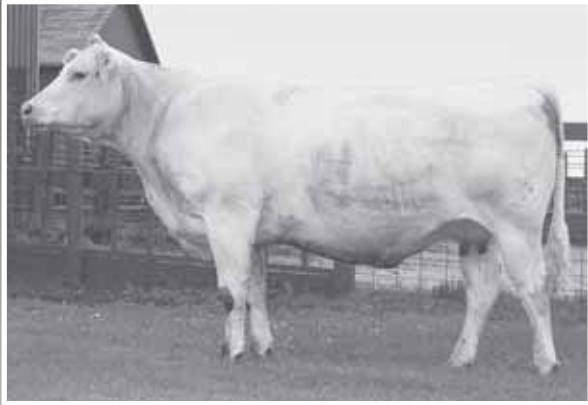

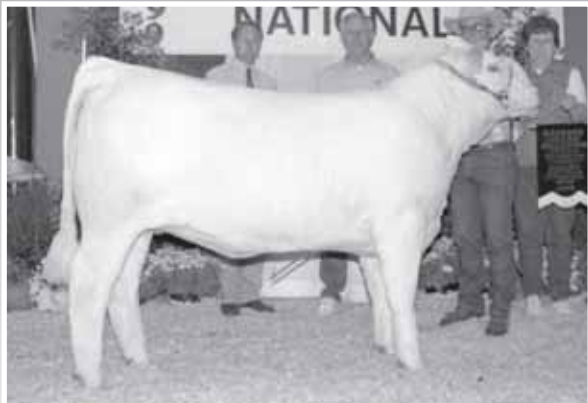

Dolly is a second generation AICA Sterling Dam of Distinction, with her first five calves ratioing at 117.2. Her fifth calf weaned at 759 lbs. and ratioed at 100, because she sold at side of dam and had no herd mates. This daughter, RAC Annabelle, was Reserve Grand Champion at the Eastern National and the New York State Fair. She was also Reserve Senior Calf Champion at the Kansas City American Royal.

Dolly has two WCR Sir Fa Mac 2244 daughters who have met the qualifications for AICA Sterling Dam with their first three calves. This makes them third generation AICA Sterling Dams.

DFH Miss Dolly J226 P ET is owned by Travis Steffensen, Arlington, SD. Her first four calves have all ratioed number one in their respective groups and have an average weaning ratio of 118. Ask Travis how he likes his Dollys.

DFH Lady Di K261 P ET is here at Benton Knolls. Her first three calves have each ratioed number one in their groups and have an average weaning ratio of 111.1.

At the present time, Benton Knolls has six Dolly daughters. (Two by Duke 914, and one each of 2244, Fasttrack, EC Bronson, and WCR Sir Impressive 8191.) She is due to calve in July to DVCR Thunder 609 P ET at 14 years-of-age. Her female maternal descendants total 16 in our small herd.

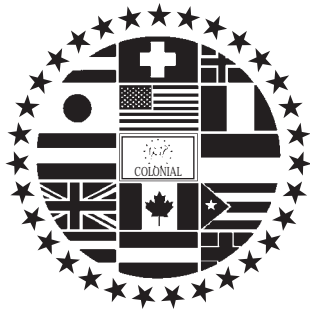
Dolly also has two of the breed's top maternal cows for herd mates. Ms Oakdale Gracie 5067P, EPDs: +3.9, +31, +57, +24, +41. Gracie's first five progeny ratioed 121.6 at Oakdale Farms. Also, HBR Lady Magnum 542 P, EPDs: +0.9, +27, +49, +40. 542 has a daughter at John White's in Georgia, with a Total Maternal of +41 and a maternal granddaughter at Greg Meyers in Kentucky, with a Total Maternal of +42.
